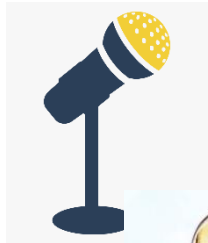

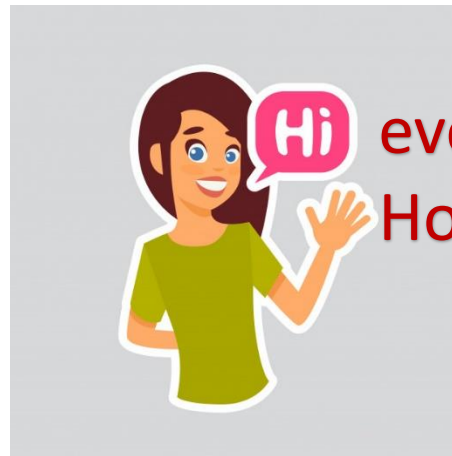

(add -ed)

work worked

What about verbs like **study and cry** that end in a consonant and **y**?
(The **y** changes to **i**, and we add **-ed**.)



For example:
cry cried

Time Expressions for the Past: yesterday, last night, last week, last month

What did you do **last night**?

I **went** out.

..... **ago**

 - It is necessary that you memorize them so that you can use them when you need them.

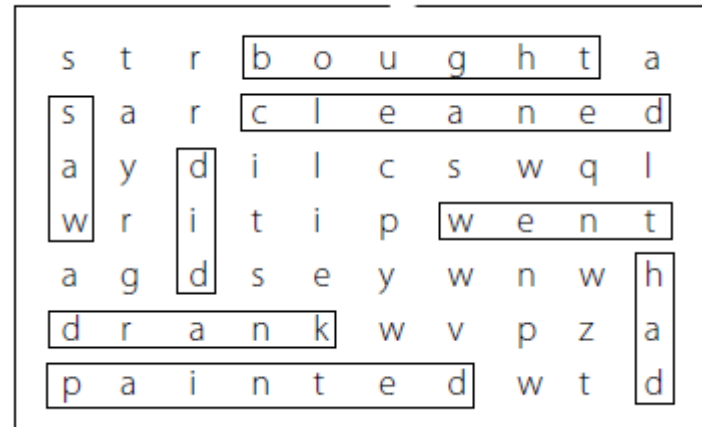
