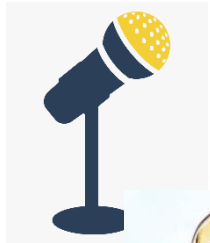

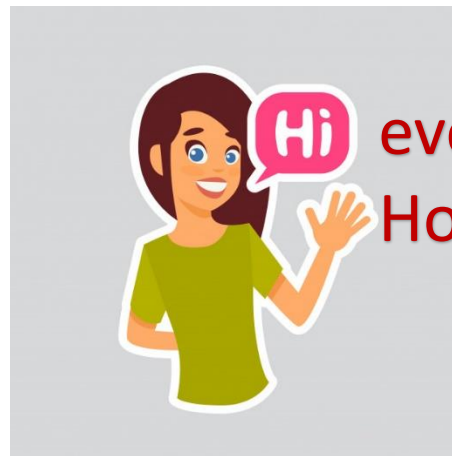

## 11 Form, Meaning and Function

We use the simple present to talk about things that are true in general, or actions that are permanent such as habits and routines. Adverbs and expressions of frequency are often used with the simple present.

*How often do you brush your teeth?*

*When do we have English class?*

*How often do you clean your room?*

*What time do you usually get up?*

A: Ali rides his bike to school every day.

B: He rode his bike to school yesterday.

A: I usually clean my room twice a week.

B: I cleaned my room two days ago.



## Simple Present versus Simple Past

Use the simple present to talk about permanent actions like habits or routines.  
We often use adverbs of frequency such as: *always, usually, often, rarely, never*.

Ali **phones** his family...

every day / every Friday / every week

**Does** Ali **phone** his family...?

on Monday(s) / on the weekend

Ali **doesn't phone** his family...

once a week / three times a month

Use the simple past to talk about actions that were completed in the past.  
We often use time expressions such as: *yesterday, last night, two years ago*.

Ali **phoned** his family...

yesterday

**Did** Ali **phone** his family...?

last week / last Friday / last month

Ali **didn't phone** his family...

two days ago / a week ago

**Note:** We can also use adverbs of frequency with the simple past.
