#### **Real Talk**

Definitely = expressing a high degree of certainty

You're out of your mind! = You're crazy!

To be honest = to tell the truth

scared to death = very frightened





Who says Definitely? (Andrew)

Why does he say it?

(Because he is sure shark diving was the most awesome experience he ever had.)

If he wasn't certain, what might he say?

(Maybe when I went shark diving.)

\*Michael's question \*:

What was the most awesome experience you've ever had?

Definitely when I went camel ridding.

Who says You're out of your mind! (Michael)

Why does he say it? (He thinks it's very dangerous to be diving in the middle of sharks.)

Who says To be honest? (Andrew)

Why might you say To be honest? (When you are admitting something that you might not want to say.)

Who says <u>he was scared to death?</u> (Andrew)

Why does he say it? (He was very frightened around the sharks.)
