


We use the <u>past perfect</u> tense when we are talking about two actions that happened in the past and we want to make it clear which action happened first.

placement of the adverb <u>already</u>, which goes before the past participle.

She wasn't hungry because she had already eaten.

They had never seen a camel until they went to Egypt.

After he had left, they arrived home.

He had left before they arrived home.

By the time they arrived home, he had left.

When I arrived at the gate, they had already started boarding the plane.

Past Perfect

Use the past perfect tense (had + past participle*) to indicate an action that happened before another action in the past. Some time expressions that are used with the past perfect are: after, already, before, by the time, ever, never, until.

Past Perfect Tense

had + past participle



By the time we **got** to the airport, our flight **had** already **left**.

After she had gone to the hotel, Amal exchanged some money.

Had you ever **eaten** sushi before you **traveled** to Japan?

No, I'd never tasted sushi until I visited Japan.

He'd had the car for ten years before he **sold** it.

Note: The contraction of had is 'd: I'd, you'd, he'd, she'd, we'd, they'd.


