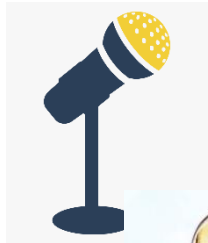

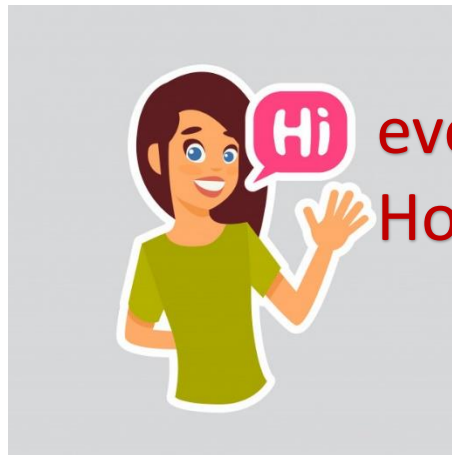

Writing Corner

In formal situations, such as at a hotel, use polite language to make requests.

1. *Would like* is a polite form of *want*.

I want to make a reservation. → **I'd like** to make a reservation.

Do you want breakfast? → **Would you like** breakfast?

2. Use *Can* / *Could* / *May* to politely ask a question.

Spell your last name. → **Could** you spell your last name?

Give me your passport. → **May** I see your passport, please?



In formal situations, such as at a hotel, use polite language to make requests.

I want to make a reservation. → I'd like to make a reservation.

Do you want breakfast? → Would you like breakfast?

is commonly used in both formal situations and in everyday conversation.

Read the examples in 1. 'd is the contraction of would.

For example:

1. I want a single room.

2. I want to stay for three nights.

3. Do you want some coffee?

4. What do you want?

1. I would like a single room.

2. I 'd like to stay for three nights.

3. Would you like some coffee?

4. What would you like?



the pairs of requests in 2.

the first sentence is in the imperative and the polite request is a question.

In questions, the modal verbs Can, Could, and May come before the subject.

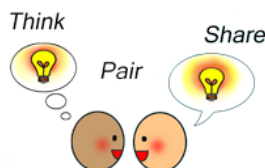
