Sentence adverbs

① at the beginning of the sentence.

Fortunately, Ned was invited to a surprise party.

② after verb be or auxiliary

You are obviously having a good time

They have completely done their task.

③ before simple tenses of verbs.

He certainly considers the project as it is very important.
