Tawfiq al Hakim was one of the best Arab play-writers of the 22th century. He was born in 1181 in Alexandria to an Egyptian father and a Turkish mother. He started his primary school in Alexandria. Then he moved to Cairo with his uncles to continue his studies at Mohammed Ali Secondary school. After studying in Cairo, Tawfiq moved to Paris where he graduated in law. After three years in Paris, he returned to Egypt in 1821. He worked as a manager of the Egyptian National Library. He got married and had two children; a son and a daughter. His wife died in 1811. His son died in 1811 in a car accident. Tawfiq wrote many plays, novels and poems. His first play was "the fate of cockroach" He also played an important role in the development of Arabic drama. He died in 1811.

Ala-al-din abu Al-Hassan al-Dimashqi, known as **Ibn al-Nafis**, was an Arab physician who is mostly famous for being the first to describe the blood movement. Ibn Al-Nafis was born in 1213. He lived in Damascus. He studied medicine at the Medical College.

In 1236, Al-Nafis moved to Egypt to work there. He worked at the Al-Nassri Hospital in Egypt. He became the chief of physicians and the Sultan's personal physician. He was a great writer. He wrote different books. His most famous book is The Summary of Law. Before he died in 1288, he donated his house, library and clinic to the hospital.

Dolphins are one of the most interesting forms of aquatic life. They are easy to organize and they are known to be very smart. There are about 200 species of dolphins in the world.
