

## **DIRECT OBJECT**

- **★** A **direct object** receives the action of a verb.
- It answers the question of what or who.

## Examples:

1) Ella bought a meat sandwich.

5 1

DO

In the above sentence, a meat sandwich is the direct object, as it answers the question, "What did Ella buy?"

2)  $\frac{1}{S} \frac{\text{met }}{V} \frac{\text{Anna.}}{DO}$ 

Here, Anna is the answer to the question, "Who did I meet?"

## INDIRECT OBJECT

- ★ An **indirect object** is the recipient of a direct object.
- It informs to whom or for whom something is being done.

Examples:

Jeremy bought his grandfather a walking stick.

S V IO DO

In this example, "his grandfather" is the recipient of the walking stick, hence "his grandfather" is the indirect object.
