Is Email Good for Social Relationships?



Most people think email is a helpful invention. It allows friends and family who are far apart to keep in touch with each other easily. Before email, it was more difficult to stay in touch with friends who lived far away. Long distance telephone calls were expensive. And letters took so long to send and receive that they didn't let people "talk" to each other. Most people agree that email has been very helpful


in allowing people to remain friends with people they do not see very often.

Moby Dick (1956), directed by John Huston and starring Gregory Peck, Richard Badehart and Leo Genn, is a TV fantasy film adapted from the bestselling novel by Herman Melville.
