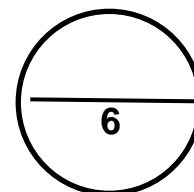

And the United Nations' International Labor Organization has said that work stress has become a global issue. What has caused work to become so stressful in the last 20 years? One reason that jobs have become more stressful is technology. Computer technology is changing quickly. This means that people constantly have to learn new ways to do their work. Another reason that jobs have become more stressful is that people work more now than they did in the past. They take fewer vacations and work more hours per week. 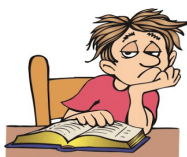
