Prompt 1:

Guided words: Environmentally harmful - practices 'Go greener' - practices Steps our local council can take to help

Unit 3

Prompt 1:

Guided words: Rooms and other places (exterior – interior – kitchen – garden) , you can (see, hear, feel and/or touch & smell)

Unit 4

Prompt 1:

Write an email to your friend giving information about your sport or recreational activity.

Guided Questions:

Where can you do this activity?

When can you do this activity? e.g., summer, winter, etc.

Do you need any special equipment to take part in this activity?

What do you have to do to prepare for this activity? What is involved in doing this activity? e.g., stages, rules etc.

Why do you like this activity?

Would you recommend this sport or activity to your friend? Why?

Prompt 2:

Describe the best sporting event you've ever seen (in person or on TV).

Guided Questions: (Answer the following questions.)

- What sport was it?
- Who was in the competition?
- Where did you see it?
- Who were you with?
- Who won?
- What made it exciting?
- Describe highlights of the game or event.

Expansion

Prompt 1:

Write an expository essay about what different colors, symbols, customs, or gestures mean in your culture. Say what you think this shows about your culture.

Guided words: Korean culture is conservative. Greetings: bowing, no smiling, no prolonged, eye contact

Prompt 2:

Write a description of an important holiday in your culture.

Guided questions: Answer the following questions in your essay:

- When do people usually celebrate it?
- What do people do to celebrate it?
- What do people usually wear?
- What do people usually eat?
