

REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

- We use reflexive pronouns after the verb when the subject and the object are the same person. It refers back to the subject.

I washed the dishes myself.

She called the president herself.

- If we use "by" before the reflexive pronouns it means "alone".

I cleaned the house by myself. I was alone.
