# REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

We use reflexive pronouns after the verb when the subject and the object are the same person. It refers back to the subject.

<u>I</u> washed the dishes <u>myself.</u> <u>She</u> called the president <u>herself.</u>

➤ If we use <u>"by"</u> before the reflexive pronouns it means <u>"alone".</u>
I cleaned the house <u>by myself</u>. I was <u>alone</u>.
