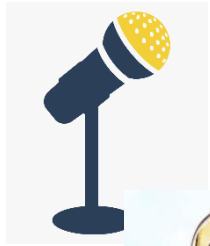

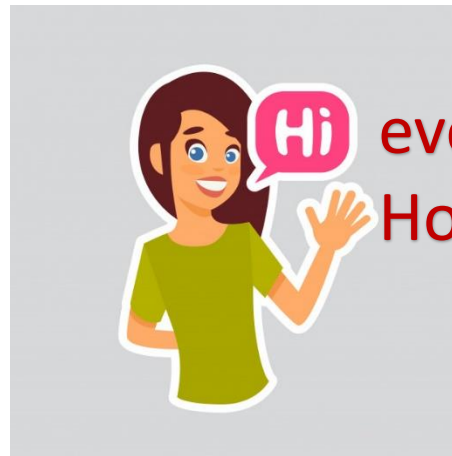

How *the* refers to specific objects or people, but it is not used when referring to plural or noncount nouns in general.

*read the examples aloud.

*more examples to show when the article is used and omitted.

For example:

Students read books. (*the* is omitted because the sentence refers to any/all students and books in general)

The books we have are in English. (specific books in our class)

Water is essential to life. (general)

Don't drink the water; it's polluted. (specific water)

What day is it today?

What time do you eat breakfast?

What do you do on weekdays?

Where do you go after school?

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The Definite Article: *the*

The definite article *the* comes before singular and plural nouns: **the** car, **the** cars. الجامعا

Use *the* for specific objects or people that were introduced before or that are known.

Do not use *the* with plural or noncount nouns when talking in general.

He is a tourist. **The** tourist is in Jeddah.

What are **the** official languages of Canada?

Technology is used in classrooms.

Use *the* with the superlative.

Planes are **the** fastest means of transport.

Use *the* for objects that are one of a kind.

the Earth **the** sun **the** moon

the stars **the** sky **the** sea

Use *the* with the names of oceans, seas, rivers, mountain ranges, deserts, groups of states, and monuments.

the Red Sea **the** Amazon **the** Eiffel Tower **the** National Museum

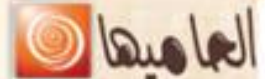
