



#### Must

Use it to talk about laws and rules and to express obligation or something that is necessary to do.

It's followed by the base form of the verb. You must <u>stop</u> at the traffic lights.

Mustn't = prohibition You mustn't use your phone while driving.

## Should

# Use it to give advice or make a suggestion that might be important.

It's followed by the base form of the verb. You <u>should</u> eat more fruits and vegetables. Negative form: Shouldn't You <u>shouldn't</u> eat too much.




