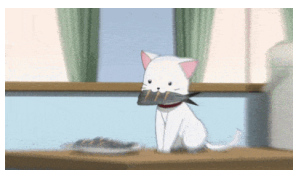

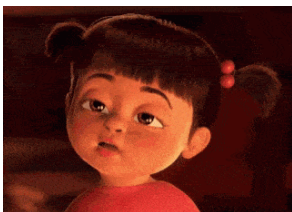

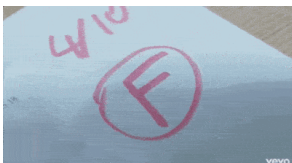

They give additional information about the function of the main verb that follows it

They are always followed by an infinitive without " to " .

**Must**

**Use it to talk about laws and rules and to express obligation or something that is necessary to do.**

It's followed by the base form of the verb.

You **must** stop at the traffic lights.

**Mustn't** = prohibition

You **mustn't** use your phone while driving.

**Should**

**Use it to give advice or make a suggestion that might be important.**

It's followed by the base form of the verb.

You **should** eat more fruits and vegetables.

**Negative form:** Shouldn't

You **shouldn't** eat too much.
