





#### Adverbs of Manner

Adverbs of manner are formed by adding -ly to an adjective. They express how something is done. Adverbs of manner usually go after the main verb or after the object of the main verb. adverb (IV)

 He drives slowly. He is reading the map carefully.

Adjectives that end in —I, double the I: careful → carefully adverb (IIV)

- Adjectives that end in consonant -y, change y to i: easy → easily adverb (ilv)


**Note:** Some adjectives and adverbs have the same form:

He's a fast driver. He drives fast. We ate a late dinner. We ate dinner late. He's a hard worker. He works hard. The mountain is **high**. They climbed **high**.



**Note:** The adverb form of *good* is *well* and the comparative form is *better*.









