What is the meaning of "summary"?

Summary means a short description that gives the main and important information about something, without giving all the details.

How to summarizing a story:

- Write about the setting (place and time), the main characters, the problem and the solution of the story.
- 2. Write only important events without details.
- 3. Put the events in the same order in which they appear in the story.
- 4. Don't repeat information, even if it's repeated in the story.
- 5. You can use your words but use vocabulary from the story when you can.
- Use category words instead of lists of words (e.g. vegetables instead of carrots, tomatoes and potatoes).

You can highlight or underline the important events to make it easy.

The important parts sometimes answer the following questions:

- 1. The king didn't find his crown.
- 2. The king looked for the crown everywhere.
- 3. The king looked for the crown in his room. He looked for it in the garden.
- 4. The king got up late so he was tired.

- 6. Everybody said they didn't see the crown.

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


