if you heat the water to 100 °C, it boils

present simple                      present simple

\* Facts which are generally true or scientific facts.

### future facts

if it rains, I will cancel the trip.

Present simple                      Future simple (will + v inf)

\* use if to talk about future  
(a possible situation in the future)

### May / Might

if I stay at home, I may <sup>inf</sup> watch T.V.

present simple

\* to suggest something is possible but not certain.

.. I'd rather .. → to talk about Preferences..

I'd rather <sup>v-inf</sup> complete my task early.

I would rather <sup>v-inf</sup> stay at home than go out tonight.

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### Conditional Sentences : Imaginary situations

IF I <sup>v2</sup> had a million SR, I would <sup>inf</sup> buy a house.  
simple past                      would + v inf

if I <sup>v2</sup> were (was) you, I would <sup>inf</sup> order pizza.

.. wish ..

for things you want to happen in the present  
Present → past simple.

I <sup>present</sup> am not tall → I wish I <sup>past</sup> were taller.

I don't have a car → I wish I <sup>v2</sup> had a car.

{ I wish I were in Paris now.  
She wish she were in Paris now. }
