





Present Perfect have/has + past participle V3

Key words :

بالفعل	للتو	حتى الآن
already	just	yet

1- already

تأتي في نهاية الجملة أو السؤال، بين have v3.

They have **already** painted the room .

They have painted the room **already** .

2- just

تأتي في الوسط بين have + just + p.p.

He has **just** gone out .

We have **just** written homework.

She has **just** cooked the food .

3- yet

تأتي في نهاية الجملة الخبرية المنفية و السؤال

Has he written homework **yet** ?

I **haven't** studied the lesson **yet** .

We **haven't** seen the new car **yet** .
