Present Perfect have/has + past participle V3

Key words:

حتى الآن للتو بالفعل already just yet

1- already

تأتى في نهاية الجملة أو السؤال، بين .v3

They have <u>already</u> painted the room.

They have painted the room <u>already</u>.

2- just

تأتى في الوسط بين .p.p + just + p.p

He has **just** gone out.

We have **just** written homework.

She has **just** cooked the food .

<u>3- yet</u>

تأتي في نهاية الجملة الخبرية المنفية و السؤال

<u>Has</u> he written homework **yet** ?

I $\underline{\text{haven't}}$ studied the lesson yet.

We haven't seen the new car yet.
