

Another important thing is who you work for. Many florists or hairdressers are self-employed meaning that they have their own company. Because of this, they don't have to worry about making their boss happy, or being promoted. Research shows that over 90% of self-employed people are happy because they are able to control their own day, but only 54% of people who work for someone else are happy.

Money doesn't always make you happy, of course Research shows that people with a pay of more than £60,000 a year are the unhappiest. Near the bottom of the list are IT workers. Despite their large salaries, only 48% love their jobs. Then, we have bankers only 44% enjoy what they do. It seems that choosing a job because of what you might earn isn't always a good idea.
